Visit by the New Leader of Cornwall Council

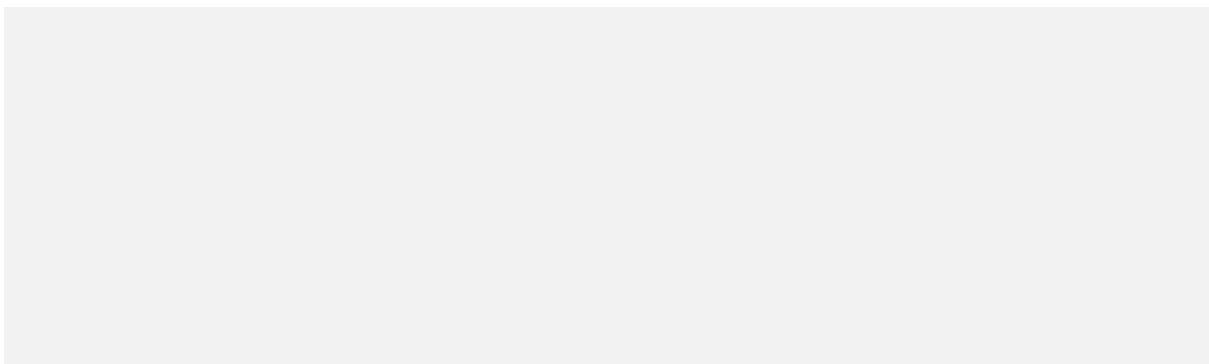
Cllr Julian German took over as the new Leader of the Council on Tuesday this week,

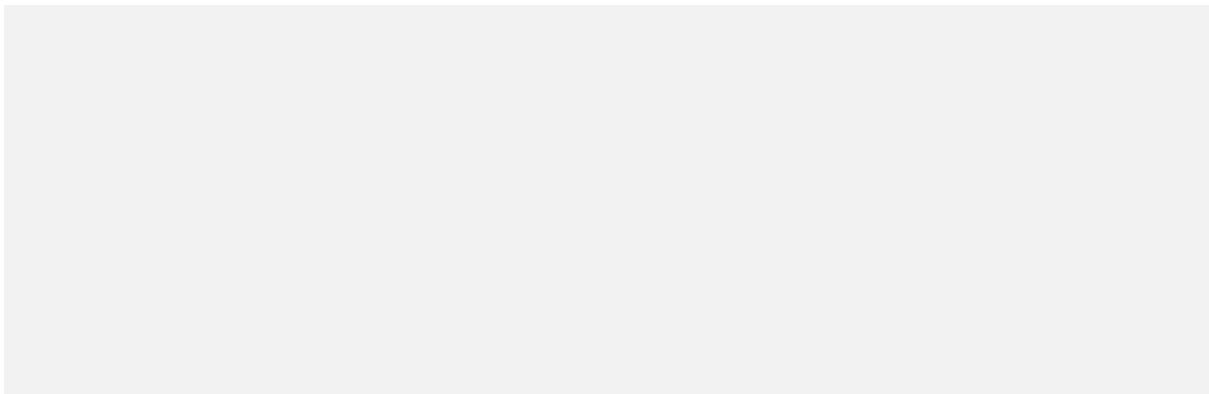
Millbrook Works Garden Project

We had a good Public Meeting this month for the Old Ship, with a site visit and a short sit-down presentation to update everyone on progress. Thanks to everyone who attended, great to see you there. The main bits of news are:

- We've got another two grants approved, to pay for the wall repair work and make the whole site safe, and to build a single-storey kitchen block at the rear of the site, where the shed is now. This will fit in behind the main three-storey building that comes later. We're hoping to start work in September – if all goes well, we'll add a temporary roof over the main area and be able to open a proper little café/bar that can run all year.
- We have a new group of volunteers in Cawsand, sorting out a programme of events for the summer period. The first one is Friday 14th June, 7.30pm, with Jake Calladine and friends playing live music. There will be a bar. Tickets will be on sale shortly, more news on that soon. Anyone interested in helping in the new group is very welcome, please contact Jenny Fox: jen-fox05@hotmail.co.uk

- We've got our full Design Team (architect, Quantity Surveyor, Structural Engineer, building control, conservation officer) working together to get us a complete and detailed design for the building. That should all be done by September, then we can start raising the main money needed.

Our target completion date is still summer 2021, even though we've had some delays already... we will keep you informed.

We welcome everyone, regardless of memory difficulties from around the Rame Peninsula, for an afternoon of gentle immersion in stimulating varied fun activities and support along with tea and cakes.

Sessions range from Poetry reading, arts and crafts, circus skills, bingo and beetle drives to visits out for afternoon tea at local cafes and country houses.

Research shows that although memory difficulties affect many of us as we age it can be helped through stimulating activities, conversation and staying active. Our aim is to support both the carers and those in need of support in our community for as long as possible.
